As an instance, designs could be decorated with drilled holes, can comprise low backs or gaps for ventilation or be made of porous materials. The seat back may be designed as an included headrest by extending the height above the occupant's head. Seats can be constructed with an attached, built in footrest or come with a separate matching ottoman. An ottoman is a short stool which is designed to be used as a movable footrest. Every now and then the ottoman could be connected to a glider chair with swing arms, allowing the ottoman to rock back and forth together with the glider similar to a rocking chair with a built-in footrest.
